Grand Marshal: Jan Caskey

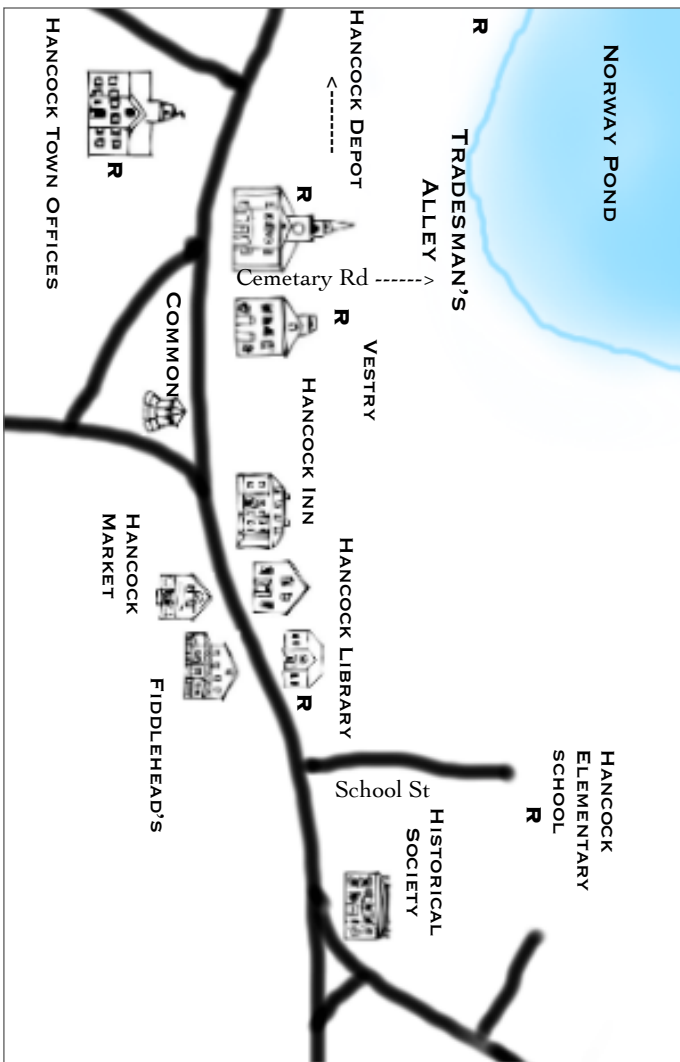
