**4:30 AM** Steady rain has iced over al the gravel roads. I have called everyone to come in and treat their routes. Does not seem to be any issues with the pavement, just the gravel at this time. Forecast is calling for rain until 9 AM, but temps will be above freezing.

**5:15 AM** 33.8° everyone is in and headed for their routes.

**5:45 AM** F-550 down with a broken spring hanger. John will try to repair at the barn, Albert will have to cover the 550's route.

**7:00 AM** F-550 is apart, John is headed for the Donovan to pick up the parts we need.

**8:00 Am** 34° with off and on light rain. Everyone is completing their first round and will b e going over their routes a second time. Around 7:30 I noticed some glazing on prospect hill, Allen will be headed their first when he starts his route.

**10:00 AM** 36°, all routes have been treated a second time, should be set for the day. The 550 should be back together in about ½ hour and ready for the next storm.
