STORM LEDGER AND CONDITIONS FOUND:

2:00 AM 30° with moderate snowfall. About 2 inches on the ground. Called everyone to come in and get hooked up, should be plowing around 3 AM.

4:30 AM 29° with heavy snow. Snowing better then 1 inch an hour. Everyone is on their routes, still waiting for Wayne to make it in. about 6 inches on the ground so far.

5:00 AM Wayne made it in and is on his route.

6:15 AM 29° with moderate snow, still exceeding 1 inch per hour, we have 8 inches on the ground so far. Everyone has completed their first rounds and are going around again. Some roads will have 4 inches or more on them. Snowfall has exceeded 2 inches per hour at times.

8:00 AM Allen came backwards down Davenport, is stuck. Kurt to take grader and get him back on the road.

8:45 Allen is back on the road.

10:00 AM Grader and Mack push back Antrim Road for house party. Bob was unable to sand completely as there were too many cars. Did sand Antrim Road heavily.

10:15 Chief Baldwin reports an oil truck off the road on Weston Road. Allen to reload and sand heavily for the removal.

11:00 AM John doing a salt run, Albert scraping Prospect hill, Allen still working on Weston Road.

12:00 AM Allen reports Weston Road is all set. Everyone else is headed in for lunch then we will scrape and cleanup all roads.

1:00 PM 34° everyone is out scraping their routes, and treating right behind.

3:00 PM 550 having fuel problems, John in to replace the fuel filter when he goes past the barn.

4:00 PM 550 back on the road. Everyone should be completing their routes within the hour.

5:00 PM 33° everyone has completed their routes, all headed home shortly. Total of 10 inches for this storm.
