STORM LEDGER AND CONDITIONS FOUND:

4:00 AM Storm just started within the last 1/2 hour. Just barely covering the ground. Called John for a salt run as we will be into commuter time before long.

4:30 AM 26° with 2 inches on the ground, must have come down real fast for a 1/2 hour. Called everyone else, will post pone the salt run and get all the trucks hooked up and ready to plow.

5:30 26° with heavy snow. We have 4 inches on the ground. Albert and Allen are just headed out. John to follow shortly and Bob after that.

6:00 AM everyone is on the road. We have over 5 inches on the ground. That is a rate of 2 1/2 inches an hour. Everyone is on their routes and working, but with snowfall rates as hard as this some roads will have a tremendous amount of snow on them before we get to them.

7:00 AM Allen reports that he has slid off the road on Willard Pond by the twin culverts. I will head with the grader to pull him out. John is back on the road and he was sent to sand the area by Allen.

8:00 AM Could not get Allen out, every time we tried to pull he slid closer to the trees. Will Call Kent's for a wrecker.

8:30 AM 9 inches of snow at the barn. John and Albert helping to put the plow on the grader so I can plow Allen's route.

9:00 AM the grader is on Allen's route starting with Kings Highway. Albert, Bob are headed for their second pass.

10:00 AM Allen is un stuck, but wrecker ran out of fuel. Phil was able to send one of his little trucks to fuel up the wrecker.

10:30 AM Allen is headed for the barn to put chains on and swap plows. John will give him a hand.

10:45 AM Allen's route is completed for first pass, Grader is headed for Prospect Hill.

11:30 AM Call from prospect hill, after plow went by road is extremely slippery. Will sand sander as soon as we have one.

12:00 PM John headed for Prospect Hill, Allen back on his route and he is headed for Willard Pond. Bob and Albert are done their second passes. They Will try to grab some lunch.

1:30 PM Call from barb, Brimstone corner is icy, UPS truck needs sand. Bob sent to treat the hill, then he will begin scraping and treating his entire route.

2:00 PM all trucks will begin scraping, cleaning up and treating their routes.

8:00 PM with light snow, all routes are set for the night, everyone is headed home and will be back at 3:30 AM to scrape and treat again. Even though we have a little light snow overnight, this storm is over with 12 inches of accumulation.
