STORM LEDGER AND CONDITIONS FOUND:

8:30 PM 33° with fairly steady rain. Will be keeping an eye on the roads for icing while everyone else gets to sleep.

10:15 PM 32.5° with light rain, has come in heavy at times. No sign of sleet or snow in the precipitation. Forecast is still calling for a change over around 11:00 PM. All gravel roads are holding their own. Some have slipper spots, but overall travelable in 2 wheel drive.

11:00 PM 32° with sleet. Roads are covered but still passable. Will hold off calling anyone for a while longer. No traffic out and emergency vehicles can go anywhere they want.

2:00 AM 30° with moderate snow/sleet. Enough to call the guys in. Snow and sleet has built up to where it will get very hard to move if we let it go for much longer.

3:00 AM 30° with moderate snow/sleet. Everyone is on their routes.

3:40 AM Bob stuck on Garand Lane. Albert to pull him out. Back on the road at 4:20 AM

4:45 AM Talked to Gary at the Bus company. Trailing edge is coming through Vermont. Asked for a 2 hour delay to give us a chance to get everything plowed.

5:00 AM Bob stuck on High Street and North Road. Had to have Allen come over from his route to pull him out. Did not get back on the road until 6:30 AM

6:30 AM 28° all trucks are back working their routes.

9:00 AM everyone has completed plowing and will begin sanding. John is headed for a salt run.

10:45 AM Bus company reports a bus stuck on Old Dublin Road. Bus meta car and pulled off to the right, front end dropped in the ditch. Allen will sand the best he can, bus company has Moto coming to pull the bus out.

11:30 Salt run done, Jon to shovel off the walks at the town office.

12:30 PM Albert and John to open drain at Library. Allen and Bob to check all gravel.

2:00 PM John, Albert and Bob to put plows on and scrape the pavement. Allen will continue checking gravel. Once pavement is scraped and treated all will go home
