STORM LEDGER AND CONDITIONS FOUND:

4:30 AM with around 2 inches on the ground and snow picking up, I will call everyone in to begin scraping their routes.

8:00 AM 5° with steady snow. Crew is ending their first rounds. We have a little over 4 inches of snow.

9:00 AM Brett reports the bell housing on the Mack has snapped. Brought it back to the shop and evaluated. With consultation from State Line we decided to run the truck with just the front plow for now. He will keep an eye on it.

11:30 AM 6.5° with moderate snowfall. We have about 6-7 inches so far. Guys will be finishing up their second rounds and grabbing lunch before heading around again.

1:00 PM 6.5°, H2 headed back around, H3 and H5 just coming in for lunch, H4 just checked his truck all over and will be grabbing lunch.

5:30 PM all trucks will be headed around again. Storm should be over by around 9 PM with just some flurries after. This should be the last trip around until early morning.

6:00 PM call from the bus company about road conditions. Reported that if the forecast held we would be all set for a normal start time. He indicated they would most likely go for a 2 hour delay.

9:00 PM all routes have been plowed, guys headed home until 3:00 AM Clouds are breaking up, moon is coming out.

3:00 AM 0° with clear skies. All are headed out to clean up. Damon will cover Brett's and Brett will cover Damon so we can get a wing on Brett's route.

10:00 AM all routes have been covered. Total snow fall around 12 inches.
