STORM LEDGER AND CONDITIONS FOUND:

5:00 AM a little over an inch on the ground. Called the guys to scrape everything off for the morning. This will be along drawn out event, getting 9-10 inches over the next 48 or so hours.

9:30 AM 17° with light snow. Will send Jeff and Damon home for rest, Ronnie and Brett will split the town up. Tim is home until 4PM and he will be back.

4:00 PM Tim in to take care of parking lots and walks. Just starting to pick up again.

6:00 PM 10° with light snow. All routes have been covered a second time. Guys will check the trouble areas and switch at 7 PM

7:00 PM 9° with light snow. Brett and Ronnie home until 3 AM, Jeff and Damon will split the town. School has been canceled.

2:30 AM talked with Jeff, have about 2 inches, next crew is due in at 3 AM.

5:00 AM 10° with light snow. Measured about 7 inches of snow. Trucks are working; Tim is up town getting ready for the stores to open.

9:15 AM 10° with light snow. Ambulance call on Ledge Road, road was scraped and treated for the ambulance. Both trucks have been around, grabbing breakfast and heading around again.

12:00 PM swapped out crew, Ronnie and Brett home until 3 AM. Damon and Jeff on until 6-8 PM.

6:00 PM Jeff and Damon headed home to come back in at 3 AM

3:00 AM 15° with about 2-3 inches more snow overnight. Everyone is headed out to clean up their routes.
