STORM LEDGER AND CONDITIONS FOUND:

10:00 AM snow starting to fall, light at first. Snow totals anticipated to be 6-9 inches.

11:00 AM Jeff on the road with plow and mix on. Will be checking hills and trouble areas. Guys will have lunch at 11:30 and then get ready to head around.

1:00 PM all on their routes, a little over 2 inches on the ground. They will plow off the pavement and wait a little on the gravel.

3:30 PM 8 Inches on the ground, 5 inches in the last 2 hours. All roads are snow covered. Everyone is headed around on their regular routes. It will take some time to open everything up.

5:00 PM 9 Inches measured up on Old Town Road. Power is out on Old Dublin Road.

6:00 PM, Damon reports tree and wires burning on Tannery Hill, Turned over the HFD.

7:30 PM All but Brett in for supper, Brett still opening up his route.

8:30 PM Everyone headed out to check there trouble spots for the night. Will plow and treat as needed.

1:00 AM everyone back on the road and leaning up.

5:30 AM all routes have been plowed, the will begin treating. Issues reported, Car in the road on Carriage Hill, low wires on Bittersweet. Tree in wires on Elmwood road, trees blocking south Elmwood road.

9:30 AM everyone headed home for Turkey Day. Total was 11 inches.
