

Minutes of the Water Commission Meeting
April 27th, 2016

Monthly Reports: The commissioners reviewed and signed off on the March water and the Quarterly Disinfection By-Product Report.

18 Main Street:

Kurt said the property owner at 18 Main Street has requested that the water be turned back on this Friday, April 29th. Linda will add a reconnect charge on to the next bill.

Meeting Time:

The commissioners will be going back to their 4:30 meeting time which will still be on the 4th Wednesday.

Assessment Grant:

Kurt said he had spoken with DES and the Deframe group regarding asset management and trying to nail down what program to go with. He said the project would be a summer long project and he has two of his guys starting to work on it.

UV System:

Kurt said after working with the engineer and the manufacturer, they have switched over to powdered chlorine. He said the liquid chlorine was produced in batches from 2015 and was causing the alarms at the chlorinator to go off. Kurt said the dry chlorine was working out very well.

Retirement:

Kurt announced his official date of retirement as DPW Director would be July 1st. He requested that with the commissioner's approval, he would like to continue on with his water duties. The commissioners were very happy to have Kurt continue on with his water responsibilities.
