

**Minutes of the Water Commission Meeting**  
**July 27<sup>th</sup>, 2016**

Attending: Joel Chandler, Sean Kerwin, Jeff Wilder, Kurt Grasset and Linda Coughlan, Recording Secretary

**PDIP Account:**

The Treasurer had provided a letter to the commission asking if they wanted her to close out the PDIP account since there was a balance of under \$2.00. They consensus of the commissioners was to keep that account open since they transfer funds from the checking account when the balance gets to a certain amount. Linda will ask the bookkeeper to print out the checking account balance from QuickBooks so they can determine the amount of funds to transfer.

**Monthly Reports:** The commissioners reviewed and signed off on the June water report.

**Owner/Operator:**

Kurt said he has switched over owner of the water operation from himself to Jeff Wilder. Kurt said he was now listed as the operator. The commission reviewed the salary for operator and came to an agreement on that figure.

**Water Usage at Juggernaut:**

Kurt said the water usage has only run over 100,000 gallons per day a couple of times. He said the level of Juggernaut is down but not as low as it had been in prior dry periods.

**Deframe Group:**

Kurt the Deframe Group has been working on asset management and had provided maps a result of their inventory gathering. The maps indicated where the hydrants and gates are located.

**UV System:**

Kurt said he met with Dave Cloutier who recommend a mixer for the UV system to help to keep dry chlorine agitated. The commissioners approved the purchase of the mixer which was \$500.00.

**PFOA-**

Kurt said he had received a letter from DES suggesting that water systems voluntarily be tested for PFOA. Kurt said this chemical is normally found in sites that have industries nearby that have produced products with this chemical (used in the manufacture of Teflon pans, etc.). He said since there has never been that type of manufacturing activity near Juggernaut, he thought they could wait until the test is required. He said he will get in touch with the contact in the letter and inform her that there has been never been activity of that kind near Juggernaut.

**Evidence of Animal Activity at Juggernaut:**

The commissioners discussed how to curb animal activity that comes too close to the reservoir. There are signs up but it seems they are not always obeyed. They will work on finding a solution to this problem.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned at 5:00 P.M. Next meeting will be on Wednesday, August 24<sup>th</sup> at 4:30 P.M.
