1. Evelien Bachrach and Matthew Seeger asked to be appointed to the Dump Committee. They will submit letters of interest to the Town Office and were invited to participate in the meeting.
2. Use of the facility by non-residents for a fee was discussed and was not recommended.
3. The Director of Public Works will have a temporary permit available for new residents or short term rentals. Some proof of occupancy will be required.
4. The Standard Operating Guidelines and Mandatory Recycling/Transfer Station Ordinance will be reviewed by the committee members with recommendations of changes for the next meeting.
5. A sign will be installed at the demolition dumpster stating that payment is required for its use.
6. A bell button will be installed in the Swap Shop to request assistance when needed from the employee in charge of the facility.
7. Swap Shop items will be added to the list of items to become the property of the town after which residents will be limited to 5 items per day.
8. The waste oil heater has developed a crack in the combustion chamber and must be replaced. The DPW Director will look into a grant from the State to pay for part of the cost. Total cost may be in the neighborhood of \$9000.
9. Next meeting is October 3 at 2:00 PM with subsequent meetings as required on the First Tuesday at 2:00 PM at the DPW. Town web site and Happenings should be revised for this change.
