Hancock Broadband Options - as of Feb. 2020

(in no order of preference)

Comcast Expansion:

- no provision or assistance w/financing of loan or bond with re-payment by new subscribers over time

X USDA Funding:

- still subject to 10/1 speed threshold for unserved qualification

Satellite:

- Space-X (and others) plans for thousands of low-orbit satellites may be realized sooner than previously assumed - (*POSSIBLY* late 2021???)

Communications Union District (CUD) Legislation - Senate Bill 457 Local:

- Senator Dietsch sponsoring, among others - (may be signed into law this year)

Consolidated Communications:

- VDSL 35B to unserved - (CCI will pay cost of Bond attorney if proposal accepted)

New Provider:

- none responded to Hancock RFP, nor have any yet proved attractive to surrounding towns
